

Call for applications for new positions in the EANO Disparity Committee 2024-2026

Dear EANO Members,

EANO is THE Association for Neuro-Oncology in Europe and has launched several committees where your support and input as experts in the field of Neuro-oncology is highly appreciated. EANO wishes to strengthen its role in supporting diversity in Neuro-Oncology-related professions in Europe and has created a new EANO disparity committee in 2019.

The Disparity Committee chaired by Karin Piil supports diversity in clinical care and research activities in the field of Neuro-Oncology. The committee focuses on identifying issues concerning disparity across Europe, exploring the needs of the EANO membership in this area, and elaborating innovative strategies to address disparity in the Neuro-Oncology community. Interactions with other EANO committees will be encouraged, and our group welcomes collaborations with other [external] disparity working groups.

The EANO is looking for active new members who will start their engagement after the EANO Meeting in Glasgow 2024. The duration of the position is 2 years, with the possibility of one re-election, depending on the input of the member.

Applicants must be members of EANO (i.e. paid-up members) with residency in a European country. Applications for the Executive Board at the same time are not possible; applications for another EANO Committee are possible by indicating primary and secondary choices, also former Executive Board members are very welcome to apply!

The election procedure will be as follows:

1. Interested candidates should send a letter of application to the EANO Board explaining their motivation and a standard CV (up to 3 pages) to the EANO Office e-mail address (office@eano.eu). The deadline for submission is **June 9th, 2024**.
2. The EANO Executive Board will review all the applications in June, taking into account the CVs, geographic representation and speciality to ensure the Disparity Committee has a broad representation.
3. At the General Assembly during the EANO Meeting in Glasgow, the Executive Board will present the approved candidates.
