

Call for applications for new positions in the EANO Executive Board 2024-2026

Dear EANO Members,

EANO is THE Association for Neuro-Oncology in Europe and is looking for an active new Executive Board member who will start his/her engagement after the EANO Meeting in Glasgow 2024.

The Executive Board is composed of representatives of different specialities and each member has specific tasks and competencies. The duration of the position is 2 years, with the possibility of one re-election. Board Members are expected to participate in teleconferences and face-to-face meetings and actively support EANO projects. A position on the Executive Board will allow you to take part in the development of our field, EANO and its many activities.

Applicants should be active in Neuro-Oncology, used to interdisciplinary and multi-professional teamwork, and education and should be interested in a prosperous future for EANO. Any specialist may apply as there are no fixed positions for the different disciplines. Applicants must be members of EANO (i.e. paid-up members) with residency in a European country.

The election procedure will be as follows:

1. Interested candidates should send a letter of application to the EANO Board explaining their motivation and a standard CV (up to 3 pages) to the EANO Office e-mail address (office@eano.eu) The deadline for submission is **June 9th, 2024**.
2. In June, the Nomination Committee of EANO (composed of the President, President-Elect and the last 3 Past Presidents) will review all the applications. The track record, the geographic representation and the speciality of the applicants will be taken into account to ensure the Executive Board has a broad representation.
3. During the General Assembly at the EANO Meeting in Glasgow, the candidates approved by the Nomination Committee will be presented. If there are two or more similarly qualified nominees for a vacant position, the election will be held by a simple majority of votes during the General Assembly.
4. Announcement and introduction of elected members will take place at the end of the General Assembly.
