

Call for applications for new positions in the EANO Educational Committee 2020-2022

Dear EANO Members

EANO is THE Association for Neuro-Oncology in Europe and has launched several committees where your support and input as experts in the field of Neuro-oncology is highly appreciated.

The Educational Committee is currently chaired by Riccardo Soffietti and concentrates its activities on the support of educational activities of EANO with focus on joint development of a structured Neuro-oncology education in Europe. Key activities are the educational program that is part of the Annual meeting and the Winter School program for young neuro-oncologists. Furthermore, the committee assists in the interaction with other societies within the focus of joint educational activities and supports the development of Neuro-oncology outside Europe.

The EANO is looking for active new members, that will start their engagement after the EANO General Assembly taking place in autumn 2020. The Educational Committee is composed of representatives of different subspecialties with balance regarding European countries and gender. The duration of the position is 2 years, with the possibility of one re-election, depending on the input of the member.

Applicants must be members of EANO (i.e. paid-up members) with residency in a European country.

Applications for the Executive Board at the same time are not possible; applications for another EANO Committee is possible by indicating primary and secondary choices, also former Executive Board members are very welcome to apply!

The election procedure will be as follows:

1. Interested candidates should send a letter of application to the EANO Executive Board explaining their motivation and a standard CV (up to 3 pages) to the EANO Office e-mail address (office@eano.eu). The deadline for submission is June 1, 2020.
2. The EANO Executive Board as well the Committee Chair, Riccardo Soffietti, will review all the applications in June/July, taking into account the CVs, the geographic representation and specialty to ensure the Educational Committee has a broad representation.
3. At the General Assembly during the EANO Meeting in autumn 2020, the Executive Board will present the approved candidates.
