

## Call for applications for new positions in the EANO Scientific Committee 2020-2022

Dear EANO Members

EANO is THE Association for Neuro-Oncology in Europe and has launched several committees where your support and input as experts in the field of Neuro-oncology is highly appreciated.

The Scientific Committee is currently chaired by Michael Platten and concentrates its activities on designing the Scientific Program of the annual EANO Congresses (selection of oral and poster presentations, invited lectures, etc) and other EANO events (or EANO supported events run by other organizations). Furthermore, together with the Board Member(s) input for the Website and the WFNOS website (advices, review articles, news) and any other scientific matter of EANO needing specific expertise (reviewing of grants and fellowships applications, projects) as well as reviewing abstracts for the conference are tasks of the Scientific Committee.

The EANO is looking for active new members, that will start their engagement after the EANO Meeting in Glasgow 2020. The Scientific Committee is composed of representatives of different subspecialties with balance regarding European countries and gender. The duration of the position is 2 years, with the possibility of one re-election, depending on the input of the member.

The following positions are now open for election:

- Medical oncology
- Neurosurgery
- Radiation oncology
- Paediatric neuro-oncology
- Neurology.
- Neuro-imaging/ Nuclear medicine
- Neuropathology
- Nursing/psychology
- Neurosurgery
- Basic Science/epidemiology/research

Applicants must be members of EANO (i.e. paid-up members) with residency in a European country.

Applications for the Executive Board at the same time are not possible; applications for another EANO Committee is possible by indicating primary and secondary choices, also former Executive Board members are very welcome to apply!

The election procedure will be as follows:

1. Interested candidates should send a letter of application to the EANO Executive Board explaining their motivation and a standard CV (up to 3 pages) to the EANO Office e-mail address ([office@eano.eu](mailto:office@eano.eu)). The deadline for submission is **June 1, 2020**.
2. The EANO Executive Board as well the Committee Chair, Michael Platten, will review all the applications in June/July, taking into account the CVs, the geographic representation and specialty to ensure the Scientific Committee has a broad representation.
3. At the General Assembly during the EANO Meeting in Glasgow, the Executive Board will present the approved candidates.
