

Call for applications for new positions in the EANO nurse/AHP Committee 2021-2023

Dear EANO Members

EANO wishes to strengthen the role and functioning of nurses and health allied personal dedicated to brain tumor patients. We have therefore decided to establish a nurse/allied health professional (AHP) Committee, to improve education, science and communication for this important topic and this important group of professionals.

The first nurse/allied health professional Committee will be chaired by Karin Piil and will concentrate its activities on developing a clinical and scientific network within EANO to embrace nurses/AHP in an enhanced manner. The Committee advocacy better recognition of the various neuro-oncological disciplines across Europe to ensure that an evidence-based care and treatment are provided to our patients and their families by highly educated, empowered and competent nurses and AHPs. We encourage more nurses/AHP to be dedicated to neuro-oncology clinical practice, scientific positions and as leaders within multi-professional teams.

The Committee will for example work with a mentor program, establish webinars and educational activities, develop a scientific nurse/AHP network to support and strengthen international research, and suggest innovative approaches to improve the neuro-oncology nurses/AHP community.

The EANO will be accepting new members after the EANO General Assembly 2021. The Nurse/AHP Committee is composed of representatives of different subspecialties and or professions with balance regarding European countries and gender. The duration of the position is 2 years, with the possibility of one re-election, depending on the "intensity of commitment" as judged by the Executive Board and Chair of the Committee.

Applicants must be members of EANO (i.e. paid-up members) with residency in a European country.

Applications for the Executive Board at the same time are not possible; applications for another EANO Committee is possible by indicating primary and secondary choices, also former Executive Board members are very welcome to apply.

The election procedure will be as follows:

1. The interested candidates should send to the EANO Board a letter of application explaining their motivation and a standard CV (up to 3 pages) to the EANO Office e-mail address (office@eano.eu). The deadline for submission is **May 31, 2021**.
2. The EANO Executive Board as well the Committee Chair, Karin Piil, will review the applications in June/July, taking into account the CVs, the geographic representation and specialty to ensure the nurse/AHP Committee has a broad representation.
3. At the General Assembly in autumn 2021, the Executive Board will present the approved candidates.
