

EANO TUMOR BOARD – TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR EVENT ATTENDANCE

Last updated: July 22, 2025

By registering for and attending the EANO Tumor Board (hereinafter referred to as “event”), you agree to the following terms:

1. Registration & Attendance

- 1.1. This is a free event, open to all EANO Members with valid EANO Membership, but pre-registration is required.
- 1.2. Spaces are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 1.3. A registration confirmation will be sent by email after the online registration. Participants may be requested to present this registration confirmation/receipt at the registration counter as proof of their registration and payment.
- 1.4. The registration name badge must be worn at all times during the event. Access to the venue will not be granted without the name badge issued by the event organiser. If a participant loses, misplaces or forgets the name badge, a handling fee of EUR 50 will be charged for a new name badge. Upon handing out a new name badge, the lost badge will be deactivated and becomes invalid.

2. Cancellation & No-Show Policy

- 2.1. If you are unable to attend, please cancel your registration at least 14 days in advance.
- 2.2. Repeated no-shows or last-minute cancellations may result in limited access to future events.

3. Event Changes & Cancellation of the Event

- 3.1. The organizers reserve the right to change the event schedule, speakers, or venue at any time. All registered attendees will be notified of any changes via the contact information provided (e-mail address).
- 3.2. In the event that the event cannot be held or is postponed due to events beyond the control of the event organisers (force majeure), including but not limited to pandemic or epidemic situations, or due to any other events which are not attributable to wrongful intent or gross negligence of the event organisers, the event organisers cannot be held liable by participants for any damages, costs, or losses incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodation costs, costs for additional orders, financial losses, etc.

4. Code of Conduct

- 4.1. All attendees are expected to behave respectfully toward others. Harassment, discrimination, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
