

Call for applications for new positions in the EANO Educational Committee 2026-2028

Dear EANO Members,

EANO is THE Association for Neuro-Oncology in Europe and has launched several committees where your support and input as experts in the field of Neuro-Oncology are highly appreciated.

The Educational Committee concentrates on supporting EANO's educational activities with a focus on the joint development of structured Neuro-Oncology education in Europe. Key activities include the educational program as part of the Annual Meeting, the EANO School of Neuro-Oncology, EANO mentorship program, and the EANO Seminars. Furthermore, the committee assists in interacting with other societies, focusing on joint educational activities, and supports the development of Neuro-Oncology outside Europe. The Educational Committee is a very active committee with a series of new projects to be implemented in the years to come.

EANO is looking for active new members who will start their engagement after the EANO Meeting in Rome 2026. The Educational Committee is composed of representatives of different subspecialties, with a balance regarding European countries and gender. In particular, we would like to encourage applications from basic scientists, radiation oncologists, pediatric oncologists and radiologists in order to further strengthen the multidisciplinary profile of the committee.

The duration of the position is 2 years, with the possibility of one re-election, depending on the input of the member.

Applicants must be members of EANO (i.e. paid-up members) with residency in a European country.

Applications for the Executive Board at the same time are not possible; applications for another EANO Committee are possible by indicating primary and secondary choices. Former Executive Board members are very welcome to apply!

The election procedure will be as follows:

1. Interested candidates should send in their letter of motivation and CV via the EventsAir

platform. The deadline for submission is **May 28, 2026**.

2. The Education Committee and EANO Executive Board will review all the applications by mid-July, considering the CVs, geographic representation, and specialty to ensure the Educational Committee has broad representation.
3. At the General Assembly during the EANO Meeting in Rome, the approved candidates will be presented.
