

Call for applications for new positions in the EANO Disparity Committee 2023-2025

Dear EANO Members,

EANO is THE Association for Neuro-Oncology in Europe and has launched several committees where your support and input as experts in the field of Neuro-oncology is highly appreciated.

EANO wishes to strengthen its role in supporting diversity in Neuro-Oncology-related professions in Europe and has created a new EANO disparity committee in 2019.

The Disparity Committee is chaired by Susan Short and will support diversity in clinical care and research activities in the field of Neuro-Oncology. The committee is focused on identifying issues concerning disparity across Europe, exploring the needs of the EANO membership in this area, and on elaborating innovative strategies to address disparity in the Neuro-Oncology community. Interactions with other EANO committees will be sought, and our group welcomes collaborations with other [external] disparity working groups.

The EANO is looking for active new members that will start their engagement after the EANO Meeting in Rotterdam 2023. The duration of the position is 2 years, with the possibility of one re-election, depending on the input of the member.

Applicants must be members of EANO (i.e. paid-up members) with residency in a European country.

Applications for the Executive Board at the same time are not possible; applications for another EANO Committee is possible by indicating primary and secondary choices, also former Executive Board members are very welcome to apply!

The election procedure will be as follows:

1. Interested candidates should send a letter of application to the EANO Board explaining their motivation and a standard CV (up to 3 pages) to the EANO Office e-mail address (office@eano.eu). The deadline for submission is **May 31, 2023**.
2. The EANO Executive Board will review all the applications in June, taking into account the CVs, the geographic representation and specialty to ensure the Disparity Committee has a broad representation.
3. At the General Assembly during the EANO Meeting in Rotterdam, the Executive Board will present the approved candidates.
